**Notice of Public Hearing on Tax Increase**

The Middle Pecos Groundwater Conservation District will hold two public hearings on a proposal to increase total tax revenues from properties on the tax roll in the preceding tax year by **7.79** percent. Your individual taxes may increase at a greater or lesser rate, or even decrease, depending on the change in the taxable value of your property in relation to the change in taxable value of all other property and the tax rate that is adopted.

The first public hearing will be held on September 4, 2018, at 6:30 PM at the Middle Pecos GCD office located at 405 North Spring Drive, Fort Stockton, Texas.

The second public hearing will be held on September 11, 2018 at 6:30 PM at the Middle Pecos GCD office located at 405 North Spring Drive, Fort Stockton, Texas.

The average taxable value of a residence homestead in **Pecos County** last year was **\$67,037**. Based on last year's tax rate of **\$0.0249** per \$100 taxable value, the amount of taxes imposed last year on the average home was **\$13.35**.

The average taxable value of a residence homestead in **Pecos County** this year was **\$71,920**. If the governing body adopts the effective tax rate for this year of **\$0.0231** per \$100 of taxable value, the amount of taxes imposed this year on the average home would be **\$16.61**.

If the governing body adopts the proposed tax rate of **\$0.0249** per \$100 of taxable value, the amount of taxes imposed this year on the average home would be **\$17.91**.
