**Notice of Public Hearing on Application for a Production Permit on  
February 19, 2019 at 10:15 a.m.**

Notice is hereby given that Crawford and Crawford, Inc has applied for a **Production Permit** with the Middle Pecos Groundwater Conservation District for a **3 well system located on Survey T&P RR CO Block 48T8 Section 27 approximately 2 miles west of FM 1776 and 8.4 miles north of 285 in Pecos County, Texas.**

The application requests a **Production Permit of 781 acre-feet/year for Industrial Use**, which shall be in addition to the existing **Historical and Existing Use Permit** for these three wells of **1,092 acre-feet/year for Irrigation Use**. The application requests to produce groundwater from the **Pecos Valley Aquifer**. The **Hearing** will be held on **February 19, 2019 at 10:15 a.m.**, at 405 North Spring Drive (**MPGCD Office**), Ft. Stockton, TX.
