Notice is hereby given that **XTO Energy Inc., an Exxon Mobil Subsidiary** has made application for a **Drilling Permit** with the Middle Pecos Groundwater Conservation District for **1 well located on 29.988 acres (Property Id# 45803) in Survey T&P RR CO Block 48 T/S 8 Section 10**, approximately 2 miles West of FM 1776 on Weatherby Road in Pecos County, Texas.

The well is projected to be **600-750 feet in depth and drilled into the Pecos Valley Aquifer.
