Notice is hereby given that **Lee Baker** has made application to **Amend an Existing Production Permit** with the Middle Pecos Groundwater Conservation District. The well system is located on **635.58 acres** in Survey **T&P RR CO Block 48-8 Section 9 (Property ID# 30301)** approximately **4 miles west of FM 1776 on Weatherby Road** in Pecos County, Texas

**Lee Baker** is currently authorized to produce **500 acre-feet/year** from a **3 well system for Irrigation Use from the Pecos Valley Aquifer**. This application requests to **add 3 additional wells** and requests to add **Industrial Use** as a beneficial need from the **Pecos Valley Aquifer**. No additional production is requested at this time. The **Hearing** will be held on **June 18, 2019 at 10:00 a.m.**, at 405 North Spring Drive (**MPGCD Office**), Ft. Stockton, TX.
