Notice is hereby given that **Belding Farms, LLC and its affiliate Cockrell Investment Partners, LP** (Belding Farms) have made Application to Amend Historic and Existing Use (H&E Use) Permit(s) with the Middle Pecos Groundwater Conservation District (District). **Belding Farms is requesting to amend its H&E Use Permits that authorize annual production of 5,880.424 acre-feet from the Edwards-Trinity Aquifer to allow production from one additional well.** This additional well (Belding Well #25/MPGCD Well #2005011506) was formerly completed in the Rustler Aquifer and recompleted solely into the Edwards-Trinity Aquifer pursuant to a Drilling Permit previously issued by the District. **This application does not seek to increase the amount of annual pumping under these permits. Well #25 is located on 233.51 acres in Survey T&P RR CO Block 3 Section 100 Property ID #3467, approximately 1 mile West of FM 2037 and Old Alpine Hwy in Pecos County, Texas.**
