

**NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING ON PROPOSED DESIRED FUTURE CONDITIONS
OF RELEVANT AQUIFERS WITHIN
MIDDLE PECOS GROUNDWATER CONSERVATION DISTRICT
IN GROUNDWATER MANAGEMENT AREA 3**

In accordance with Texas Water Code § 36.108, the Middle Pecos Groundwater Conservation District (District) will receive public input at a hearing on the proposed desired future conditions (DFCs) of groundwater resources located within Pecos County and surrounding areas located within Groundwater Management Area (GMA) 3. The District's proposed DFCs for the next year 50-year regional planning cycle are:

Capitan Reef: average drawdown not to exceed an average of 4 feet in 2070 compared with 2006 aquifer levels

Dockum: average drawdown not to exceed 52 feet in 2070 compared with 2012 aquifer levels

Edwards-Trinity (Plateau) and Pecos Valley Alluvium: average drawdown not to exceed an average of 14 feet in 2070 compared with 2010 levels

Rustler: average drawdown not to exceed 69 feet in 2070 compared with 2009 aquifer levels

These DFCs were proposed during a meeting held October 21, 2020, by the districts wholly or partially located within GMA 3, which include Middle Pecos Groundwater Conservation District and Reeves County Groundwater Conservation District.

Pursuant to Texas Water Code § 36.108(d-2), a 90-day public comment period began on October 28, 2020 which is the date the proposed DFCs were mailed to the GMA 3 districts. Comments may be submitted orally or in writing during the District's hearing or in writing to the District's office, Attention General Manager Ty Edwards, 405 North Spring Drive, Fort Stockton, Texas, 79735. After this hearing and comment period, the District will compile for consideration at the next joint planning meeting of the GMA 3 districts a summary of relevant comments received, any suggested revisions to the proposed DFCs, and the basis for any revisions.
