and Existing Use Permit Public Hearing

Notice is hereby given that **2T Partnership LTD** has made **application to Amend an Existing H&E Use Permit(s)** with the Middle Pecos Groundwater Conservation District. The permits are located on **640 acres (Property Id# 6921)** in Survey T&P RR CO Block 48 T/S 9 Section 30, approximately 16 miles West of Fort Stockton and 6 miles North of Interstate 10 in Pecos County, Texas.

The application requests authorization to **add 1 well as an additional point of withdraw** from an existing H&E permit. **The applicant currently is authorized to produce from a 5 well system totaling 6,883 ac/ft a year for Irrigation Use from the Edwards Trinity Aquifer.** The Hearing will be held on **February 18, 2020 at 10:05 a.m.**, at 405 North Spring Drive (MPGCD Office), Ft.
