Notice is hereby given that **Mandujano Brothers** has made application for a **Drilling Permit** with the Middle Pecos Groundwater Conservation District for **3 wells located on 640 acres (Property Id# 6756) Legal Description: 885 48-8 T&P Sec 23, approximately 2 mile West of FM 1776 and 1 miles South of Weatherby Road, in Pecos County, Texas.**

The wells are projected to be **800-1000 feet in depth and drilled into the Pecos Valley/Edwards Trinity Aquifers. The estimated rate of withdraw is 3 wells at 900 gallons per minute total and the purpose of these wells will be for Irrigation Use.
