**Notice of Hearing on Application to Amend  
Existing Historic and Existing (H&E) Use Permits  
February 18, 2020 at 10:15 a.m.**

Notice is hereby given that **Alvaro Mandujano, Sr. and Mandujano Brothers** have made **application to Amend Existing H&E Use Permits** with the Middle Pecos Groundwater Conservation District (District). No additional volume of water production has been requested. The application requests authorization to **add (1) a location of use to the H&E Use Permits and (2) four existing wells as additional points of withdrawal from the same aquifer and within the same management zone as authorized under the H&E Use Permits.**

The H&E Use Permits to be amended are tied to **333 acres (Property Id# 14165) (Legal Description: 5069 C-2 PSL Sec 19 S/2)**, which are **adjacent to applicant's property associated with this application (Sec 30)**, both which are approximately **three miles South of Coyanosa and 1.5 miles West of FM 1776** in Pecos County, Texas. The H&E Use Permits currently authorize **1,303 ac/ft per year for Irrigation Use from a three-well system that withdraws from the Pecos Valley/Edwards-Trinity Aquifer** and, if amended, would allow production of this 1,303 ac/ft per year from the four wells on applicant's property and irrigation use on applicant's property.

The **Hearing will be held on February 18, 2020 at 10:15 a.m.**, at 405 North Spring Drive (District's Office), Fort Stockton, Texas.
