Notice is hereby given that a 90-day public comment period opened on October 28, 2020 to take comments on proposed Desired Future Conditions for aquifers located in the District, which were adopted by designated representatives of Groundwater Management Area 3 districts at a joint planning meeting held on October 21, 2020, pursuant to Section 36.108 (d-2) of the Texas Water Code.

**The aquifers for which proposed Desired Future Conditions were adopted are:**

**Capitan Reef Aquifer**  
**Dockum Aquifer**  
**Edwards-Trinity (Plateau) and Pecos Valley Alluvium Aquifer**  
**Rustler Aquifer**

The District will issue separate notice for and hold a Public Hearing to take oral and written comments on these proposed Desired Future Conditions **on January 19, 2021**.
