The Middle Pecos Groundwater Conservation District (District) will hold a public hearing to receive public input on a proposed increase in the District's fee for exporting groundwater outside Pecos County and the District's boundaries. In our ongoing efforts to ensure responsible management of local groundwater resources, this increase is proposed to carry out the statutory purposes in Texas Water Code § 36.207(b), which include assessing and addressing impacts associated with groundwater development. Texas Water Code § 36.122(e-1) provides for an annual 3% increase, which is proposed to increase the rate to approximately 21.22 cents for each thousand gallons of groundwater exported from the District.
